

Fire Drill and Evacuation Policy

We ensure our premises present no risk of fire by ensuring the highest possible standard of fire precautions. In the unlikely event of a fire, the staff has been trained to remove children quickly safely and calmly. A fire drill will be carried out every half term to comply with current fire regulations.

Fire Drill Procedure

- A member of staff will be responsible for checking all accessible areas of the building to ensure no one remains behind.
- The owner (Katie Hopkins) or room supervisor will gather the children and adults in front of the main fire exit in the main hall (depending on location of fire).
- We will then exit the building quietly and calmly.
- Once outside, we will gather at the far end of the second car park, near the container, well away from the building. This is our assembly point.
- The owner or room supervisor will collect the register and registration folder and proceed to the assembly point.
- Once at the assembly point, the register will be taken, and the emergency services called.
- Non walking children to be evacuated via pushchair.

It is essential that all parents are aware of our Fire Drill Procedure. This can be found on our parent's notice board.
